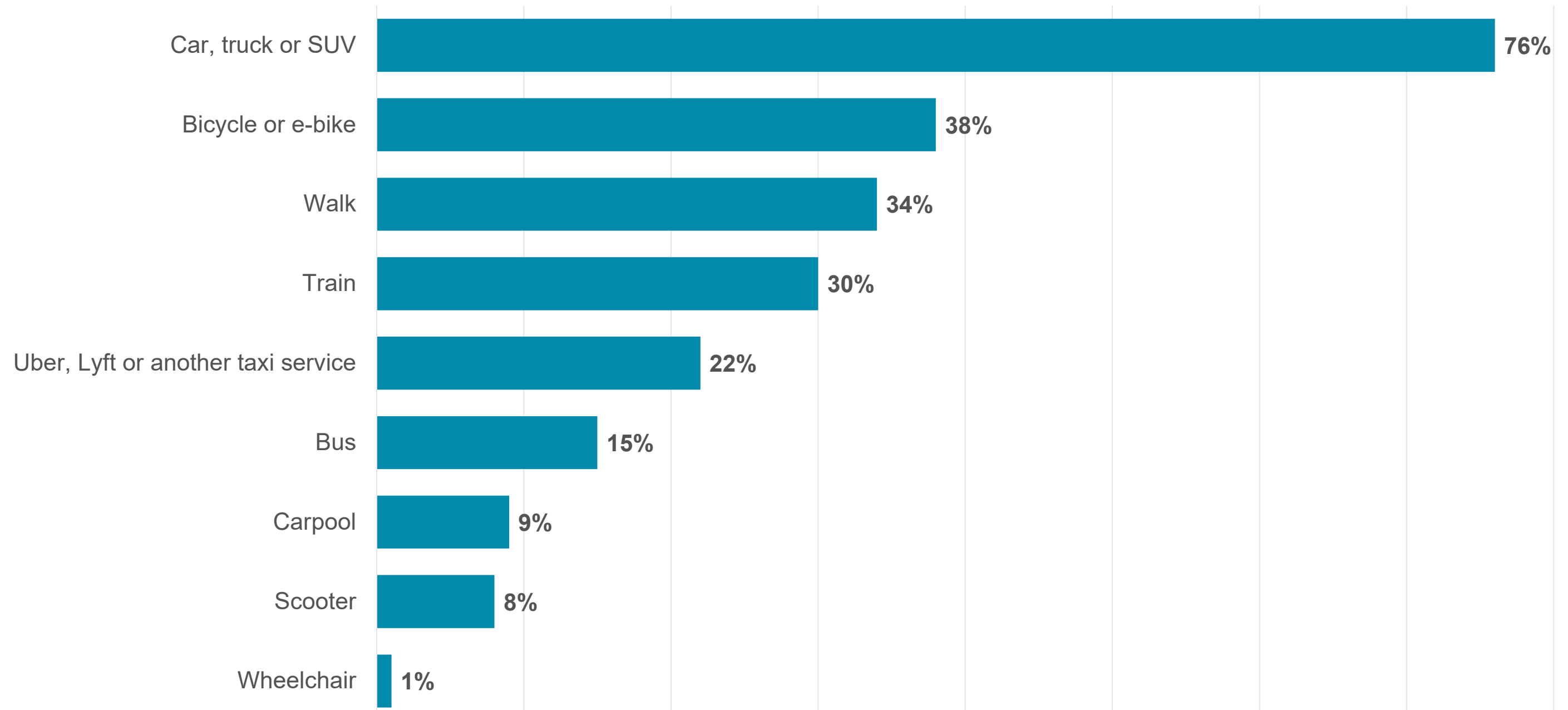

E. 9th Street Pier



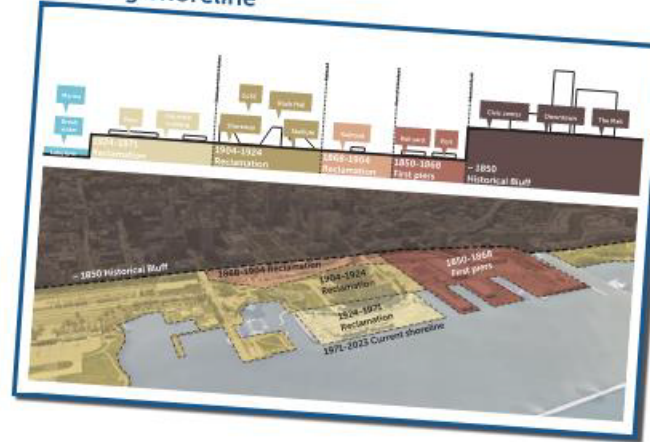
- Ice cream stand behind Captain Frank's

The working, industrial waterfront was always a place of wonder and entertainment. It can dovetail well with re-imagining places.

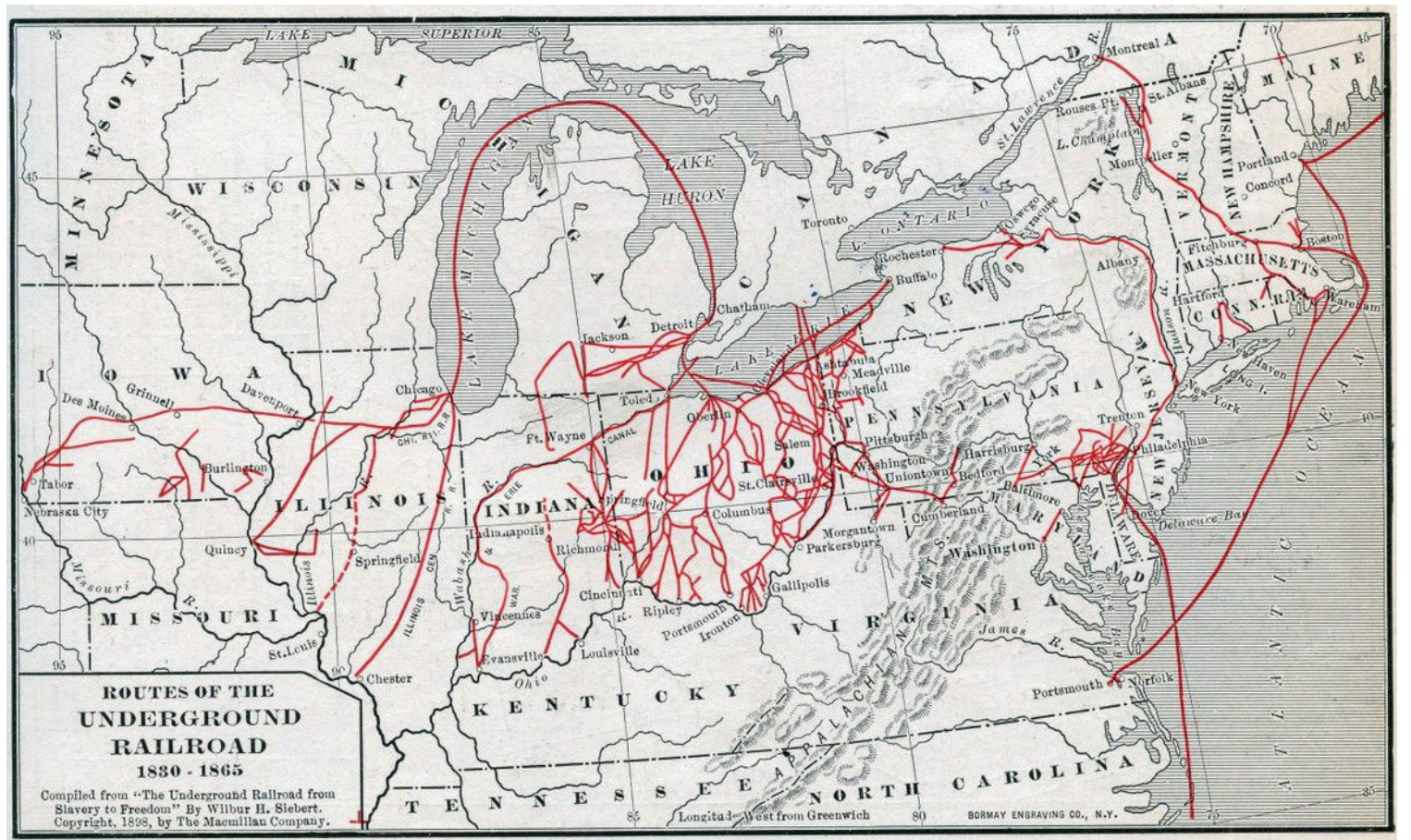
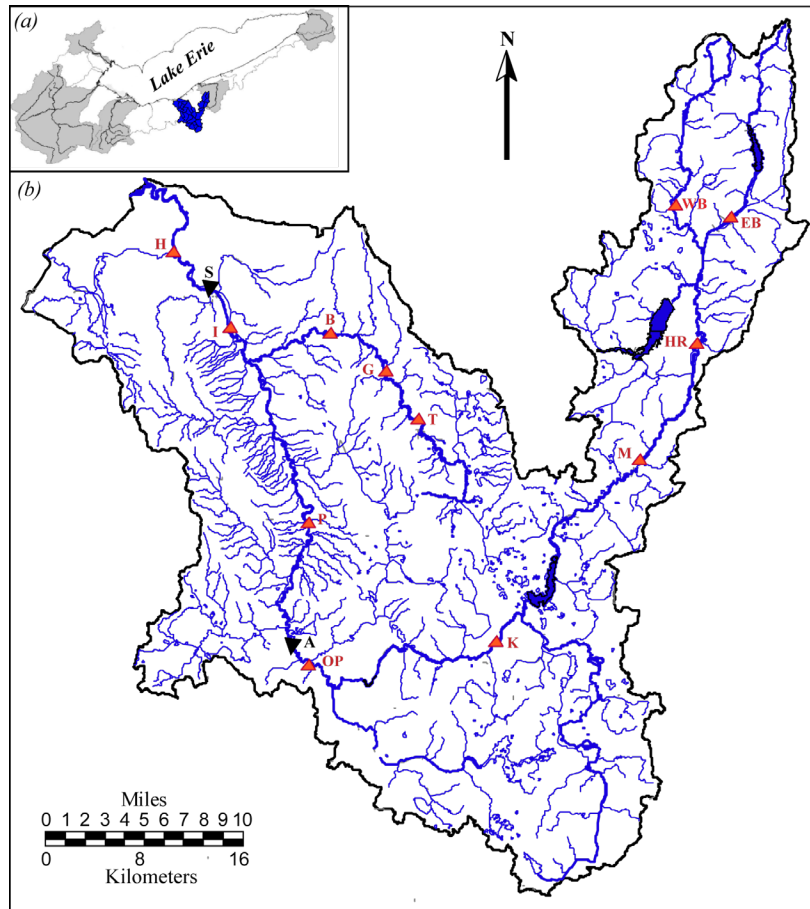
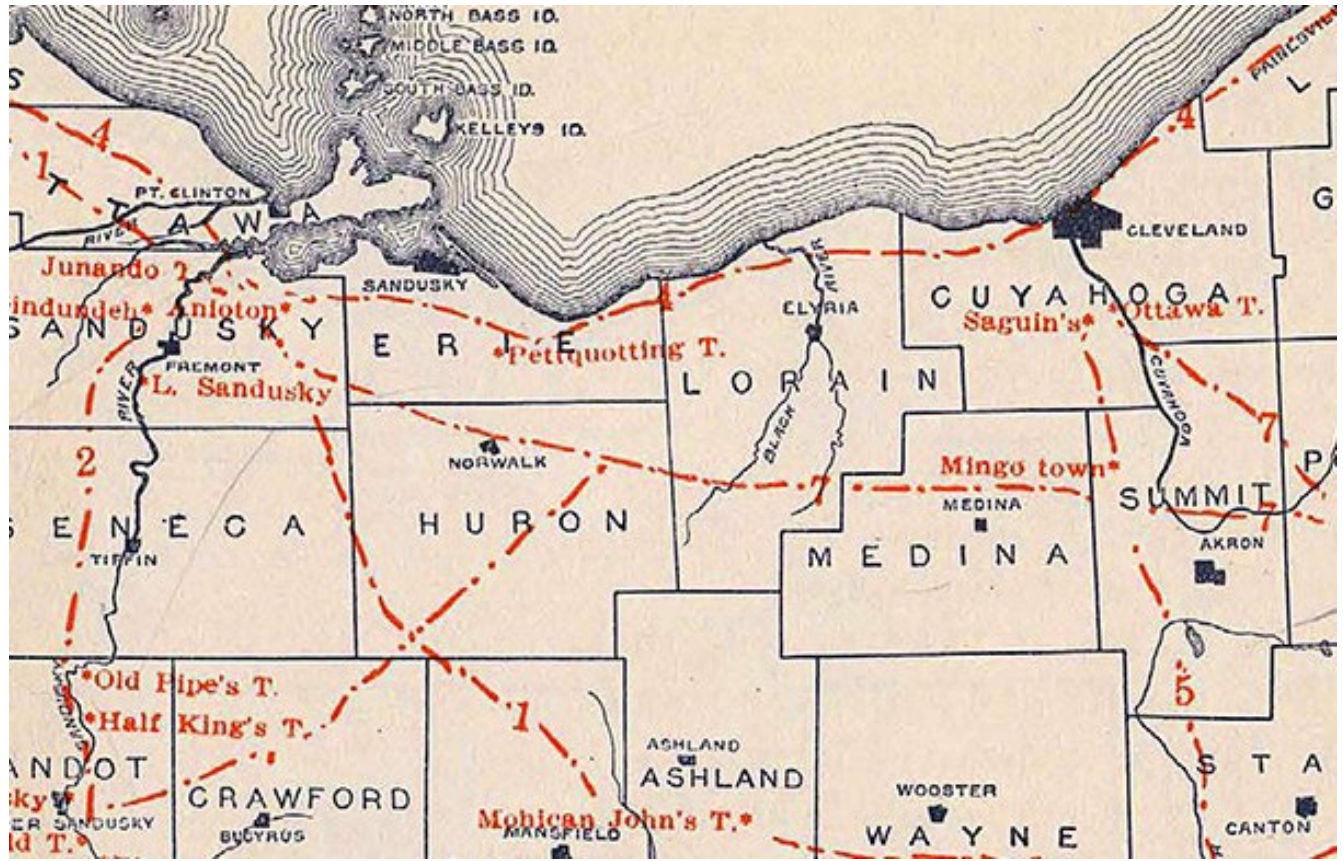

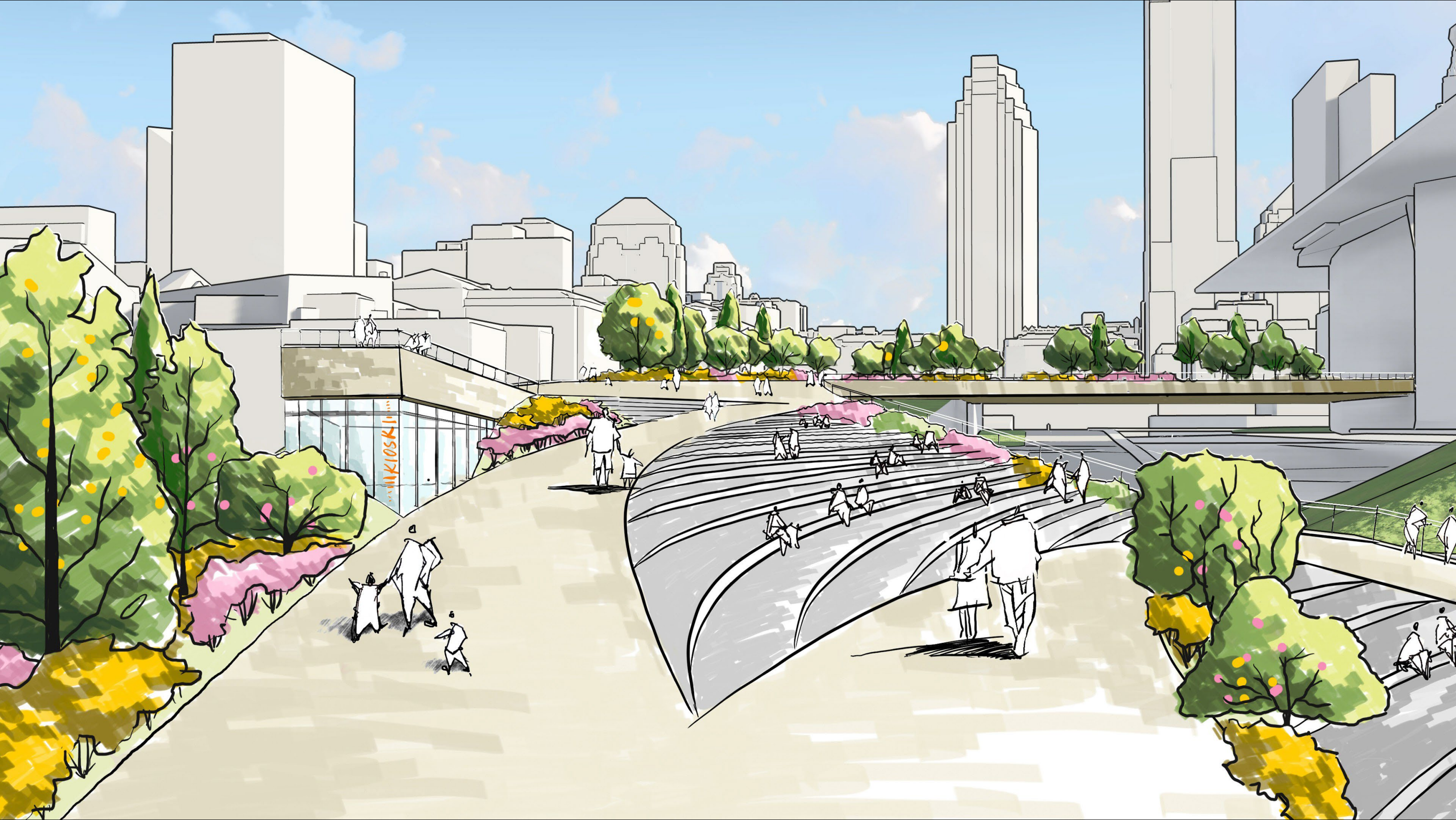
Land Bridge Guiding Principles

- Primary gesture should be to the Lake
- Create a dynamic experience
- Ensure light to the convention center
- Reinforce the pedestrian approach from the edges of Mall C
- Orientation towards western sunset views
- Create a dialogue with Voinovich Park

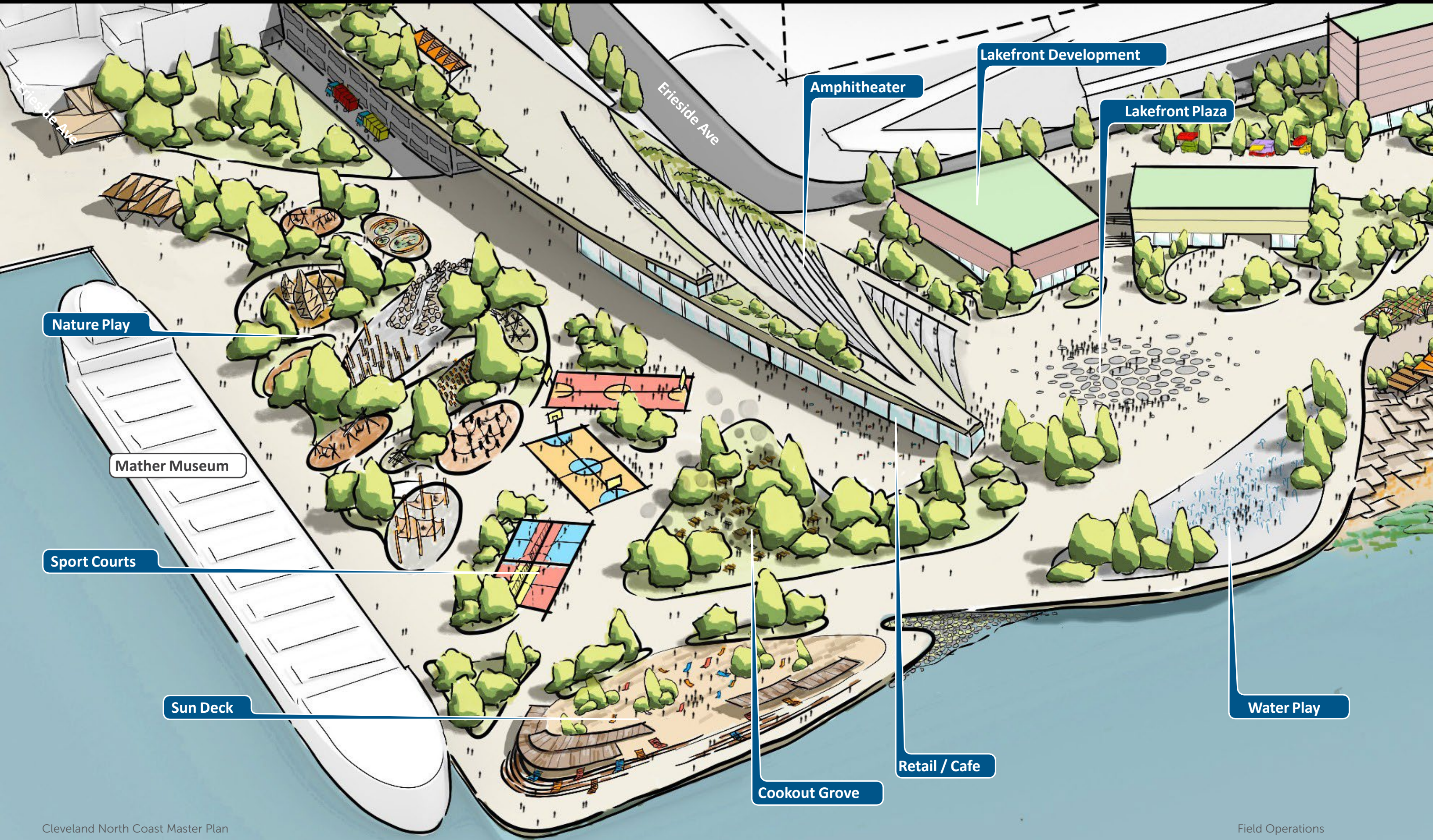
